Point-to-Point

at Lockinge on Easter Monday

In support of the Thames Valley Air Ambulance

Held at Lockinge Point-to-Point Course near Wantage, this Easter Monday family favourite is easily accessed from Newbury, Oxford, Swindon and the surrounding areas. Listed in Tatler Magazine's 4 Smartest Point-to-Points, it provides a range of opportunities to display your branding or showcase your products during the day via sponsorship, hospitality, advertising or trade stands. The Point-to-Point audience is a refined mirror of jump racing at large, attracting a 70% ABC1 demographic of largely affluent rural land and property owners.

The gender balance is fairly equal throughout this family activity and, in contrast to much of horseracing, is centred around the efforts of horse and rider rather than betting.

Sponsorship

Those providing sponsorship of £500 or more will get a free half page in the Programme.



Title Sponsorship

This is by negotiation and is the only sponsorship that might include some exclusivity.

Race Sponsorship

- Ownership of the race name (The XXX Member's Race), and the opportunity to present the prizes for your race.
- Opportunity to display your branding for race presentation and associated press coverage.
- PA announcements throughout the day thanking each race sponsors with a brief description.
- Complimentary full page Race Card advert opposite their race entries.
- Advertisement or information on the big screen, to be provided
- Prominent banner display in the Paddock.
- Listing in the 'Major Sponsors' section of the website.
- 4 x complimentary car passes to the event.

There are 6 Point-to-Point Races & 2 Pony Races available to sponsor and tenders as above will be considered.

Fence Sponsorship

- Ownership of fence name (The XXX Fence) and branding included on course map in the Race Card.
- Banner display on the back side of fences (fence banners maximum height 45cm).
- Race will be referred to as 'the XXX fence' by the race commentator during each race.
- Advertising rate in the Race Card reduced by 50%.
- Listing in the 'Other Sponsors' section of the website.
- 2 x complimentary car passes to the event.

There are 9 fences available and rates vary from £200 to £350 depending on location.

Hospitality

An ideal opportunity to entertain clients and guests, there are two areas available for hospitality:

- For 30 guests or more, there is space for up to 3 to be erected in a prime position close to the paddock and the trade stands for a site fee of £1000 with costs for the power & marquee to be met by hospitality provider. Four complimentary car passes are included.
- For smaller numbers, there are 8 individual spaces on the right-hand side of the hill overlooking the course which can be reserved. Each space will be sufficient for two cars and a mini marquee, the provision of which is the responsibility of the host. Banners advertising a company may be erected within each space or on the mini marquee. The 8 spaces on the hill are £300 and two complimentary car passes are included.

All that we ask is that you invite your clients to join you on the day and consider providing them with car passes should you wish to do so!

The Dog Show

The Second Ring will be close to the Paddock and the Bookies and is overlooked by the 8 mini marquee sites. There will be a series of dog races and shows during the day and children are encouraged to take part with their dogs. The opportunities for sponsorship include:

- Ownership of the ring name (The XXX Ring).
- Banner advertising in the Show Ring.
- Announcements throughout the day on both the main event site PA and the independent Show Ring PA system.

- The presentation of prizes.
- Complimentary half page Race Card advert and branding included on the site map in the Race Card.
- Listing in the 'Major Sponsors' section of the website.
- 2 x complimentary passes to the event.

Tenders from £750 for all of the above package will be considered, but individual sponsorships could be negotiated.

The Farmers Bar

The Farmers Bar is a cash bar hosted by members of the OBH and is there primarily to provide a venue for supporters of the day and the hunt. It provides the opportunity for a local business to show their support for the local community and traditionally any sponsorship goes towards providing some complimentary drinks to those judged by those behind the bar to deserve a drink.

Car Passes

Complimentary car passes are sent to 350 landowners and farmers in the Old Berks Hunt Country, which includes a large part of South Oxfordshire, West Berkshire and East Gloucestershire, owners of the horses entered, parents of children in the 2 Pony Races and Trade Stands. The back of the hanging car passes provide an advertising opportunity.

Sponsorship in kind or tenders from £500 will be considered.

The Viewing Stand

A viewing stand was a successful introduction in 2023. Situated close to the official's marquee, it is primarily there for those who have connections to the race, either through sponsorship or to those riding, or who merely want a good view of the course and the final bend. Entry is not restricted. Benefits of sponsorship will include:

- Branding to the back of the stand.
- Complimentary full page advert in the Race Card.
- Listing in the 'Major Sponsors' section of the website.
- 2 complimentary passes to the event.

Tenders for this package from £500 and above will be considered. Sponsorship in kind will also be considered.

Hats and Gilets for the Staff

Branded hats and gilets for the officials on the day, including those car parking and selling raffle tickets.

Sponsorship in kind or tenders from £500 will be considered.

Signage for the Car Park

The car park includes extensive signage for the car park rows and each sign can carry the sponsors details.

Tenders from £1,500 will be considered.

The Big Screen

The big screen was introduced in 2024 and proved to be very popular. In addition, there will be smaller screens in the main bar and the Farmers Bar. These will show live all the races and provide greater coverage of the various sponsorships. As well as sponsors being able to use the big screen to provide more coverage and information, there is the opportunity for a sponsor to sponsor the big screen and get regular coverage.

Tenders from £1,500 will be considered.

Advertising in the Race Card

Race Cards are A5 full colour and have 64 pages. 3,000 are printed and distributed on the day or sold to the public.

Trade Stands and Exhibitors

An excellent opportunity to showcase your products and services. Trading hours on the day are 10.30am to 6.00pm and the site will be accessible to Trade Stands and exhibitors from 10.00am on Easter Sunday (or before by arrangement only) with security on site from 5.00pm until 7.00am Easter Monday. Tractor assistance will not be available after 8.00pm on Monday until 9.00am on Tuesday.

All Trade Stands & exhibitors will benefit from:

A two line listing in the Race Card with contact details.

A 20% discount on any further advertising in the Race Card.

A listing on the website, live as soon as your invoice is paid.

All Trade Stands will pay a minimum site fee of £250 except for drinks outlets for which there will be a minimum fee of £350. We are happy to discuss options for your particular needs and our aim is to limit the number of trade stands that are similar.
